

### Report from the Villa HOA Board

The Villa HOA Board of Directors met on Monday, November 4 in the Villa Clubhouse. Among the issues discussed:

Board President Joe Karlovits submitted his resignation from his position and Board seat due to health reasons effective immediately. The Board accepted his resignation and took action to appoint Lou Sperduto to Joe's unexpired Board seat. The Board then voted Betty Ann Copley Harris as Board President and Lou Sperduto, Vice President. Remaining officers are Leslie Bloom, Secretary; Patti Wells, Treasurer and Jean Liesmann, Director.

The Villa 2019 Budget year-to-date is showing a deficit. The expense overrun can be attributed to the increase in roof repairs required this past year and to landscaping issues. A lower-than-budgeted property insurance premium will help defray part of the deficit amount. The Board had just received a rough draft of the 2020 Villa budget and will be reviewing that for

Progress on the roof replacement project continues with insurance adjusters and engineers scheduled to be on site within the community for select days in December. A schedule will be distributed to all units as the adjusters must have access to every villa in order to make their assessment. While the bulk of the massive tree trimming project is completed, there remains a few trees that still have to serviced. Chris McCluskey, property manager, will be coordinating that final effort of tree trimming.

Paver repairs are scheduled to take place November 18 for those areas that are in need of repair. The owners of the affected villas will be notified about repairs around their properties.

Also, mulch will be installed during the week of November 25 and will take several days to complete. Remember, mulch is only installed by the landscapers on the front beds of our Villas. If you want mulch applied around back, you are responsible for purchasing and installing. The mulch must match the style and color of that laid in the front.

Beginning January 2020, all villa owners must submit to Chris McCluskey a copy of the declarations page of your property insurance policy so that he can verify that all villas are insured. You can contact your insurance carrier about providing that information to Chris McCluskey on your behalf.
