Villa Board Meeting

The Villa HOA Board met on Wednesday, September 14 at 4 pm in the Villa Clubhouse.

Committee Reports

Sue Mason, Pool/Clubhouse Liaison, reported that the pool deck is in need of painting. The Board decided to add that project to the 2023 budget.

Insurance Claim to Replace Roofs

To update our on-going insurance claim to replace our roofs, the Board reviewed an engineer's report recently commissioned. It stated while less than 25 percent of our roofs sustained total damage, the issues are the availability of the tiles currently in use and the unsatisfactory condition of the tiles that could be harvested from our roofs now. Therefore, a repaired roof using existing tiles would be in violation of current building code and the roofs must be replaced. The findings of this report will strengthen our case for full roof replacement currently pending with the Florida Insurance Guaranty Association. Stucco Removal

The Villa's pest control vendor has indicated that a small section of the bottom of the exterior stucco walls of our units needs to be removed in order to properly treat for termites. With a careful eye on the budget, the Board voted to move forward with the stucco removal if funds are available in December. If not, the project will commence in 2023.

Clubhouse Awning Replacement

The Board approved a proposal to replace the exterior awning over the sliding glass doors in the Clubhouse.

Villa HOA Financials

Hearing resident interest in seeing the monthly financial reports for the Villa HOA, the Board agreed that each month the Villa's Balance Sheet and Income Statement will be posted on the Villa's website.
